Call for Access and Admission to the Doctorate Program in Economic and Management Sciences

In accordance with Article 17 of the General Regulation for Doctorate Programs of the University of the Azores, it is announced that applications for the Doctorate Program in Economic and Management Sciences are open on the Ponta Delgada campus.

1. Vacancies

- -5 (Economics specialty);
- 5 (Management specialty).

2. Access conditions

The following can apply for the cycle of studies leading to a doctoral degree:

- a) Holders of a master's degree, or legally equivalent qualifications.
- b) Holders of a bachelor's degree, or legally equivalent qualifications, that have a particularly relevant academic or scientific curriculum, recognized by the Scientific Council as attesting the capacity to carry out this doctorate.
- c) Holders of a school, scientific or professional curriculum that is recognized by the Scientific Council as attesting the capacity to carry out this doctorate.

3. Application Submission

3.1. Applications will be processed according to the following schedule:

- **3.2.** The submission of applications will be carried out exclusively electronically at https://inforestudante.uac.pt/nonio/security/login.do, and it must be accompanied by the following documents:
- a) Duly completed application form.
- b) Identification document (mandatory only for foreign candidates).
- c) Motivation letter.
- d) Detailed curriculum vitae (that allows a judgment of merit or preference).
- e) Certificate(s) of qualifications, issued by the competent entity, with an indication of the grades obtained by discipline and the final average of the degree.
- f) Curriculum evidence.
- g) Final work theme.
- h) Field of knowledge and specialty.
- i) Field of Science and Technology (FOS classification).
- i) Final work title, even if provisional.
- k) Keywords.
- I) Language in which the final work will be presented.
- m) Name(s), nationality, and affiliation of the advisor(s).
- n) Declaration of acceptance of the advisor(s).
- o) Work plan and respective schedule according to the normal duration of the doctorate program.
- p) Financing sources, if applicable.
- Note 1: Whenever the documents mentioned above are in a foreign language other than Spanish, French or English, the translation into Portuguese must be presented by a translator recognized by the Portuguese diplomatic representation.
- Note 2: A candidate can submit two applications, one for each area of specialization (economics or management) and for this purpose must submit two independent forms, which will lead to two applications, with the respective application fee on each one.
- 3.3. Uploading documents and certificates via the Internet portal is mandatory and does not exempt the delivery of original or duly authenticated documents to the Academic Services of the University of the Azores, whenever they deem to be necessary.
- **3.4.** All documents proving qualifications obtained abroad must be authenticated by the official education services of the respective country and recognized by the Portuguese diplomatic or consular authority, or carry the Hague Convention apostille, and the same must happen to the documents' translations whose original language is not Spanish, French, or English.



4. Application fee and tuition

4.1. The application fee is €70 (non-refundable). Its payment should preferably be made by ATM (payment details are generated after the application is sent). The payment can also be made in person at the treasuries of the University of the Azores in Ponta Delgada or Angra do Heroísmo.

Only applications whose payment has been made within the application deadline will be considered valid.

- **4.2.** Candidates who prove to be residing abroad must make the payment within the deadline by bank transfer, and for this purpose must contact the Academic Services through the address <u>queroestudar@uac.pt</u>, or by credit card, in a safe and secure manner, without additional costs. The proof of payment must be attached to the registration form.
- **4.3.** Enrolling in this doctoral program requires the payment of a fee of 2,535.00 euros (two thousand five hundred and thirty-five euros).

5. Admission and ranking of the candidates

- 5.1. Candidates will be ranked based on the application of the following criteria:
- a) Academic curriculum, in particular the areas and classifications of the master's and bachelor's degree (50%);
- b) Scientific curriculum, in particular research experience and publications (10%);
- c) Professional experience (10%);
- d) Work plan (30%).
- **5.2.** The evaluation of the candidates' curriculum and professional experience will be carried out based on the criteria set out in the attached grid (Annex I).
- **5.3.** Whenever the number of applications is equal to or less than the total number of vacancies, and once the admission conditions have been verified, the candidates will not be ranked. The results will be presented in alphabetical order.

6. Disclosure of results

- 6.1. The results of the applications are published on the WEB portal of the University of the Azores.
- **6.2.** The submission of complaints takes place within three working days following the posting of the results referred in the previous number, using a specific form available at http://servicosonline.uac.pt.
- 6.3. The result of the complaints is published on the WEB portal of the University of the Azores.



7. Registrations/Enrollments

Registration and enrollment take place within the indicated deadlines. Non-enrolled students will not be authorized to attend classes.
