Introduction to Scholarships of Shanghai Ocean University

CSC - Chinese Government Scholarship

In order to promote the mutual understanding, cooperation and exchanges in various fields between China and other countries, the Chinese government has set up a series of scholarship programs to sponsor international students to study and conduct research in Chinese universities.

China Scholarship Council (hereinafter referred to as CSC), entrusted by the Ministry of Education of the People's Republic of China, is responsible for the enrollment and the administration of Chinese Government Scholarship programs.

Shanghai Ocean University is one of the Chinese leading universities where offers a wide variety of academic programs in science, engineering, agriculture, economics, legal studies, management for scholarship recipients at all levels.

This is a full scholarship to recruit outstanding international students for undergraduate and graduate studies in China.

1. Supporting Categories

Chinese Government Scholarship programs sponsor international student to undertake degree studies including Bachelor, Master and PhD studies in China.

2. Duration

Chinese Government Scholarship covers both major study and Chinese language (preparatory) study.

3. Instruction Language

(1) Undergraduate scholarship recipients must register for Chinese-taught credit courses. Scholarship recipients of Chinese-taught programs without HSK 4 Certificate can apply to take one-year preparatory courses and to pass the required test before moving on to their major studies. Failure to reach the required language proficiency will lead to the automatic termination of scholarship.

(2) Graduate students can register for either the Chinese-taught program or the

English-taught program. Scholarship recipients of Chinese-taught programs without HSK

5 Certificate can apply to take Chinese language courses for one academic year to reach

the language requirements before moving on to their major studies. Failure to reach the

required language proficiency will lead to the automatic termination of scholarship.

Master's students: CNY 3,000 per month;

How to apply for Scholarships at Shanghai Ocean University

1. Application Information

Programs & Duration:

Undergraduate program: 4 years

Postgraduate programs: 3 years

Applicant Eligibility:

(1) Applicant must be a non-Chinese citizen in good health.

(2) Age and education background:

Applicant applying for undergraduate programs, should obtain a high school degree or

above and be no more than 25 years old; for master's programs, applicant should have a

bachelor degree or above and be no more than 35 years old; for PhD programs, applicant

should have a master's degree or above with academic research ability, and be no more

than 40 years old. Applicant applying for the pre-college program should obtain a high

school degree under the age of 23 years old.

(3) Outstanding in academic performance.

submit all required application documents .

2. Passport copy

- A clear copy of your valid passport with name, photo, birth date, place of birth, date of issue, and date of expiry clearly visible.
- Visa page is required for applicants who are currently living outside their country of residence
- 3. Degree certificate and transcripts of previous education

If applying for Bachelor Degree programs, please provide High school graduation certificate and transcripts of all grades.

If applying for Master's Degree programs, please provide Bachelor Degree Certificate and Transcripts of all grades.

If applying for Doctoral Degree programs, please provide Bachelor & Master's Degree Certificate and Transcripts of all grades.

- Copies of the original certificate with the school's official stamp and/or the signature
 of the principal. If the originals are not in Chinese or English, they must be translated
 and notarized.
- For applicants who haven't graduated, pending receipt of graduation certificate, copies of all transcripts available at the time of application are acceptable. However, official graduation certificate and transcripts of all grades must be submitted promptly after being received.

4. Language Proficiency Certificate

If you are applying for Chinese-taught programs, please provide HSK Certificate received within the last2 years:

- For undergraduate Applicants: HSK 4with a score above 180
- For postgraduate Applicants: HSK 5with a score above 180

If you are applying for English-taught programs, please provide Certificate of IELTS 6.0 or TOEFL IBT 80 or above, received within the last two years. Students submitting any other English proficiency certificate may be asked to provide supplementary materials. Applicants whose native language is English do not need to provide these documents.

5. Resume:

Written in English or Chinese, including your personal information, educational background, work or intern experience, achievements so far, etc.

Applicants for Master's and Doctoral Programs need to provide these additional documents:

6. Personal Statement

An essay statement written in English or Chinese on one page of A4 size paper. Introduce why you are applying, describe your interest and enthusiasm for your chosen major, and how your previous studies or experiences relate to it. Describe what makes you suitable, such as relevant skills, experience, or achievements gained from previous education, work, and other activities.

7. Research Proposal:

Written in English or Chinese, including research achievements thus far (e.g. title and abstracts of graduation thesis or published paper), reasons for choosing SHOU, study objectives while attending SHOU, future research and career plans, etc.

8. Two Recommendation Letters:

Written in English or Chinese by 2 different professors or associate professors from previous academic institutions. Can also include work supervisors, etc.

9. Supervision Confirmation Letter from Professors of Shanghai Ocean University.(optional)
